

BILINGUAL EDUCATION & TEACHING ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE

The growing population of limited English proficient students is legally entitled to an equitable education. English is the lingua franca of the world. The result is an increasing demand for teachers trained to work with children and adults in bilingual and ESL (English as a second language) programs here and abroad. To address this need, the College of Santa Fe at Albuquerque offers the following 24-credit hour programs.

Bilingual Education Endorsements

Proficiency in Spanish or a Native American language is required prior to beginning one of these programs.

TESL Endorsement

The TESL Endorsement and Certificate do *not* require proficiency in a language other than English. Both Bilingual Education and TESL Endorsements require completion of NM elementary (K-8) or secondary (7-12) licensure.

TESL Certificate

This certificate is conferred by CSFA and does not require completion of either elementary or secondary licensure. However, a student must hold a B.A. upon entering the certificate program. The TESL Certificate is designed for those who wish to teach children and adults here and abroad where a teaching license is not required.

In addition to the above bilingual and TESL programs, CSFA offers Bilingual and TESL strands in the Master of Arts in Multicultural Special Education (MA/MSE). This coursework is described elsewhere.
